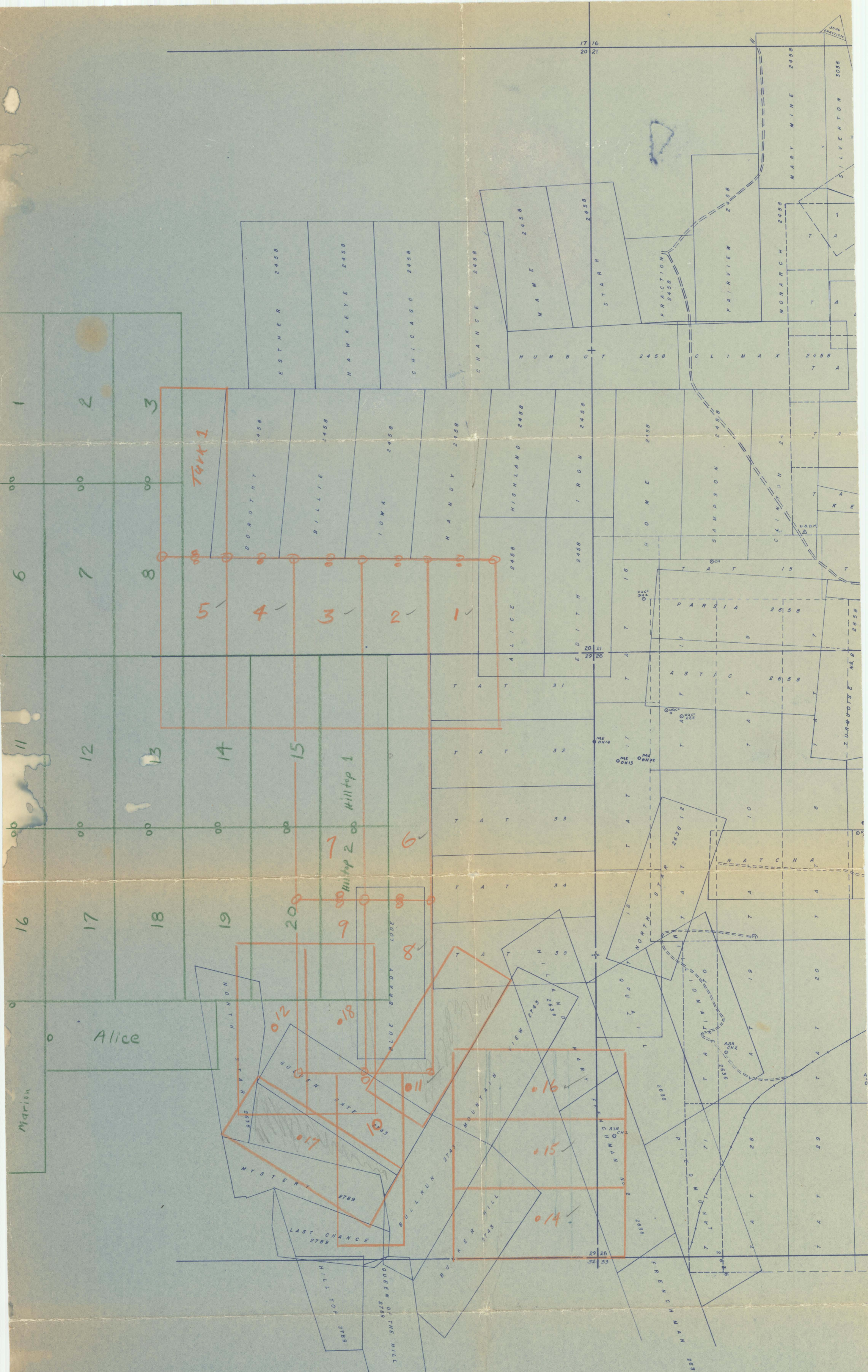

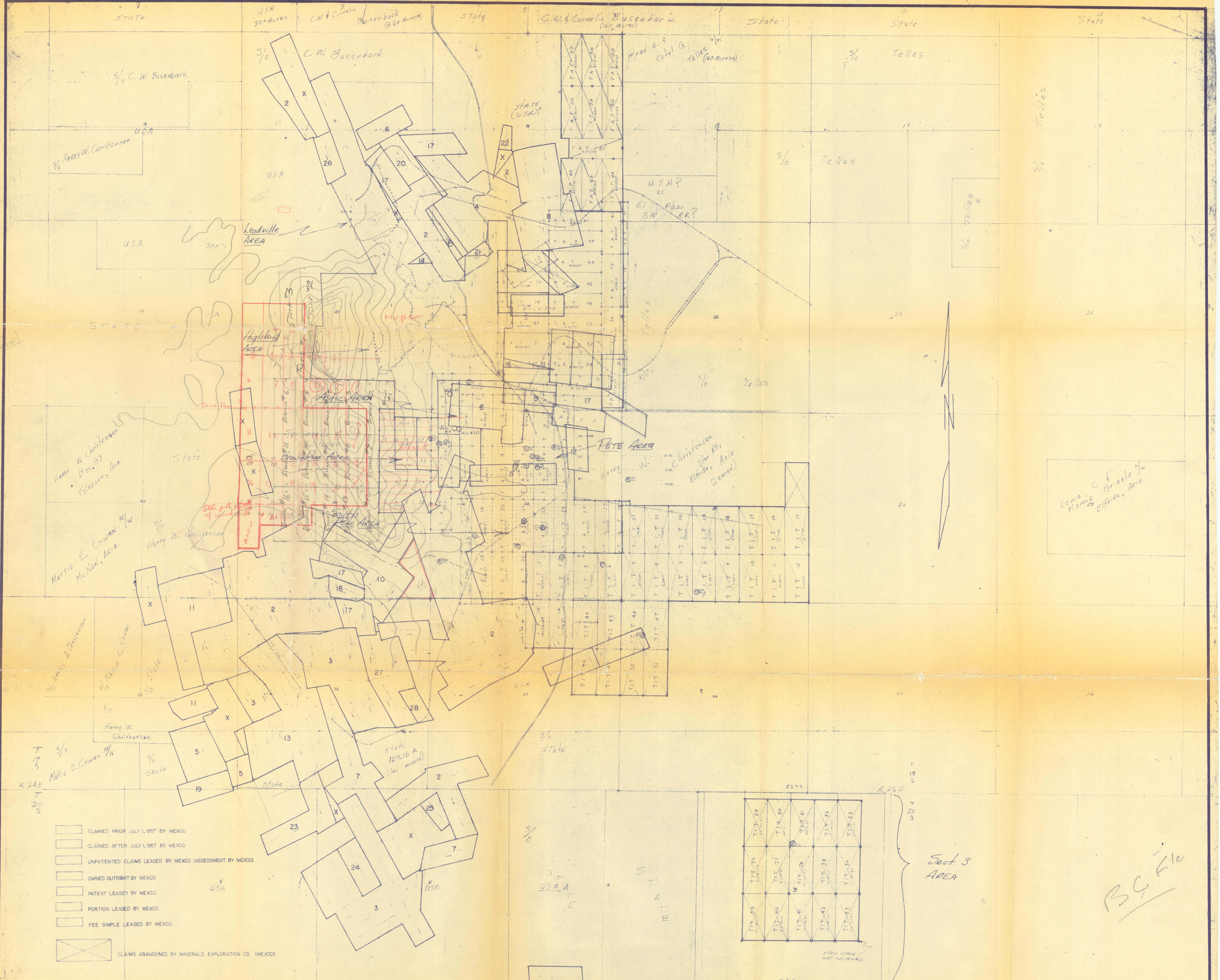

Dear Ned:

I checked through the file on the Brown's Peak work and all I can do is repeat what was shown on the map and in my letter to you of 5 April 1960.

Wait checked the courthouse records on 1 April 1960 and no Hidden Copper Claims Nos. 4, 5, 9 or 10 had been filed. If Spaulding had located them on the ground on a line continuing eastward from Nos. 3 & 8, his location monuments for 4 & 9 would have been on the patented Dorothy Claim and 5 & 10 would have been on the patented Billie claim. So, because he had either not located them, or they were not valid, open ground existed and we staked the Turk No. 1 with the intention of staking Turk No. 2 adjoining to the north. However, we were already over-extended on time by a full day and after discussing it with you on 4 April 1960 we did not go back to stake Turk No. 2.

We did not actually survey any of Spaulding's work but looked for and found and checked many, in fact most, of them on the ground. I am quite convinced that Turk No. 1 is a valid claim and am reasonably sure that Spaulding did not have any monuments up or posts at that time that would cover that part of the ground. On the other hand I cannot state positively that he did not.

This probably does not help you much. If you think of anything more I can add that might help, let me know.



CONTRACT NO. 1 - COURTLAND-GLEESON

Dear Mr. Heinrichs:

This will confirm the arrangements made between you and Mr. Eisenbrey during the week of March 20-26, 1960, for the location and staking of mining claims in the Turquoise Mining District, Cochise County, Arizona, for Bear Creek Mining Company.

1. The work to be done consists of the locating and staking of not more than twenty (20) Federal mining claims in the Turquoise Mining District, Cochise County, Arizona. The claims shall be located according to the Federal mining statutes to fill existing fractions between and near the Hidden Copper Group and the surrounding patented claims. The work will include the setting of all location monuments and such corners as directed by a representative of this company. A map showing the claims and their locations will be submitted to this office.
2. You agree to begin this work by March 28, 1960, and complete it by April 4, 1960.
3. You agree to do this work at a rate of \$44.70 per claim, not to exceed a total amount of \$894.00. You will provide all equipment and supplies, transportation, food and lodging necessary for the completion of the job.

4. You represent that you are an independent contractor and have the necessary materials and equipment to do the work set forth above.
5. Any taxes of any nature, arising out of or in connection with the work, including sales and use taxes and contributions required under any federal or state unemployment law or social security law, will be assumed and paid by you.
6. You agree to submit with this contract evidence of the following insurance:
 - a. Statutory Workmen's Compensation and/or Employers Liability Insurance covering accidental injury or Occupational Disease (including death) sustained by employees during employment.
 - b. Comprehensive automobile liability insurance with bodily injury limits of \$50,000 each person and \$100,000 each accident and with a property damage limit of \$10,000.
 - c. Comprehensive public liability insurance including contractual liability coverage with bodily injury limits of \$50,000 each person and \$100,000 each accident, and property damage limits of \$100,000 each accident.
7. In consideration of our engaging you to perform the work described in this letter contract with you dated March 25, 1960, with respect to the location and staking work, you agree to indemnify and hold harmless Bear Creek Mining Company, its successors and assigns, from any claim, expense, loss, damage or liability by reason of or arising from the performance by you, your employees, agents or subcontractors of the work described in said letter contract.
