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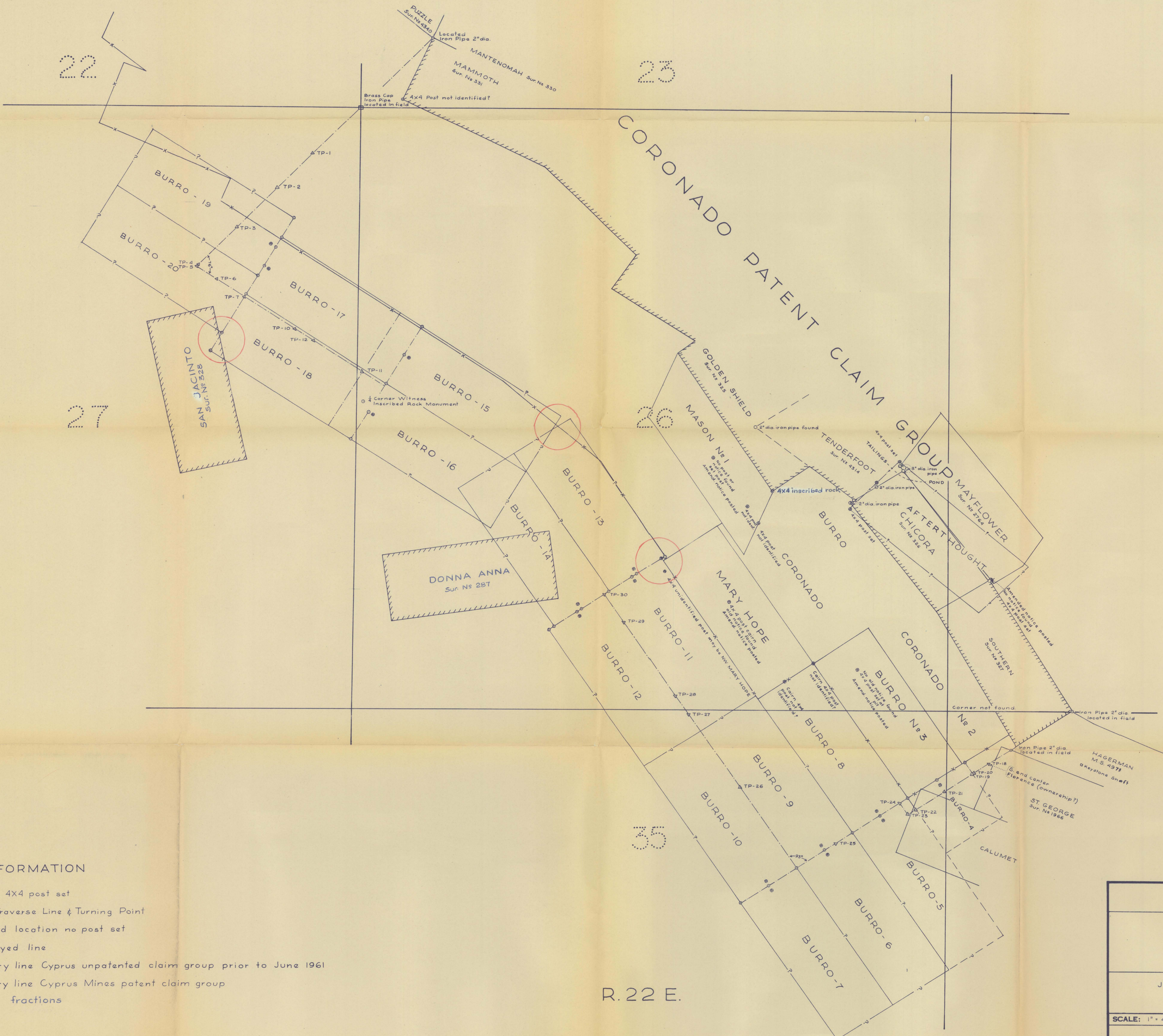




Dear Lewis:

Enclosed is the Johnson Camp claim map that I discussed with you by phone today. Along the bottom edge the pencil lines show what we have in mind for additional claims to be staked. As shown, there are 17 marked BURRO, four through 20. The arrangement of these claims is not fixed except that this seems to be a practical layout, so if you have suggestions, please incorporate them into your work when we ask that the staking be done.

Verity is in the process of starting patent proceedings for BURRO, BURRO #3, CORONADO, CORONADO #1, CORONADO #2, MASON #1, MARY HOPE and AFTERTHOUGHT, the latter being a small sliver between MAYFLOWER and CHICORA patented claims which was overlooked during previous patent proceedings.

Dear Vic:

Enclosed you will find seventeen (17) original recorded notices of the following lode mining claims all located in the Johnson Camp Area, Cochise County, Arizona Mining District: Burro 4 through Burro 20 inclusive. Also enclosed is an original and one copy of a Quit Claim Deed assigning the above claims from me to Cyprus Mines Corporation. I am also enclosing a map for your files of the Burro Claim Group.

On Monday, July 3, 1961, Lewis Molina and I graced out the northerly end of the Afterthought claim and set the NW corner by Brunton and pace, 50' due south from the NW corner of the Chicora. We then proceeded to set the North end center post 30' N of N end center of the Chicora. We then located the NW corner of the Mayflower which is located out in the middle of the tailings pond and Mr. Molina assured me he would locate the NE corner of the Afterthought 50' due north of the NW corner of the Mayflower when the condition of the tailings pond permits, which is anticipated to be in about two weeks time. Mr. Molina then directed me to the location post of Afterthought and an amended notice was posted. No old notice was found.

Mary Hope location monument was located and identified. The 4" x 4" post 2' long with a small rock cairn surrounding it and the old notice was found in a can in the cairn. The new amended notice was posted with the old notice.

Burro No. 3 location pit was located by Brunton and pace from the Mary Hope location monument. No identified monuments were located on the south east end of the Mary Hope and the N.W. end of Burro No. 3. No old notice or monument was found. However, a pit was found and a new 4" x 4" post and notice was placed at this point.

Mason No. 1 location pit was found by Brunton and pace from the SW corner of Golden Shield and Brunton and pace from two unidentified 4" x 4" posts which were assumed to be the S end center of the Mason No. 1 and N end center of the Coronado.

Upon completion of the survey for patent of the Mary Hope and the Burro No. 3 the following monuments should be checked to close any possible fractions that may exist:

1. NE Burro 11
2. Location monument Burro 4

Possible fractions as follows may also exist between Burro 18-20 and the San Jacinto and between Burro 13-15 and the Mineral Monument No. 2

An unsuccessful attempt was made to try to locate the NE corner of San Jacinto and to check for a fraction, however no other corners were searched for on the San Jacinto and this should be done to determine if a fraction does exist on the ground.

On the SE end of the claim group, there is evidence of second party interest and claim staking. The south end center of the Florence (Keystone unpat. claim?) has been tied in to the map. Other claim corners were noted apparently belonging to the Florence group and were located on the Coronado No. 2.

Your check in the amount of \$28.00 and your letter to Mr. Newbury along with the amended notices for the Mary Hope Mason No. 1 Afterthought and Burro 3 were delivered in person.

As per instructions, the five unpatented lode claims of the Shasta Group have also been delivered to the Cochise County recorder's office for recording.

# Notice of Location (LODE)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the BURRO 20 lode mining claim was located by E GRUVER HEINRICH on JUNE 21, 1961. This claim is 1,500 feet in length along the vein or deposit of mineral-bearing rock in place and 300 feet in width on each side of the middle of said vein or deposit at which this notice is posted. The general course of this claim is NORTHWESTERLY 30 DEGREES EAST and is situated in the Cochise Mining District, Cochise County, Arizona. This claim runs from the location monument or stake on which the notice is posted 50 feet in a EASTERLY direction to the EAST center end monument or stake and 1450 feet in a WESTERLY direction from the location monument or stake to the WEST center end monument or stake, and is also marked by two corner monuments or stakes at each end of the claim, one on each side of and 300 feet from the center end monuments or stakes, making the claim in the form of a parallelogram.

Dear Bill:

We have your letter of June 7 and attached map.

In general, the claim arrangement you show is fine. As a detail point, do you think there would be an advantage of making the common corner of Burro 13 & 15 also common with the W corner of Coronado 1 ? Of course the main point here is not to leave a triangle fraction between Burro 15 & 13 and Mineral Monument 2.

Aerial photos of the area are available from: Soil Conservation Service, Cartographic Unit, Ross Building, 209 SW 5th Avenue, Portland, 4, Oregon, as separate vertical stereo photos as flown, or as semi controlled mosaic 15' quads. The latter is one sheet at 1" = 1 mile, or four 7½' quad sheets at 2" = 1 mile. We have one of the latter on hand which is the SE¼ of Arizona quad 433. Indexes of the vertical stereos are also available, but without this you could safely order about nine stereo pairs, centered approximately on the common corner of Sections 23, 24, 26, T15S, R22E for about \$10.00.

We will await your further word.
