

Gentlemen:

Confirming our phone communications with Ted Eyde on August 19 and August 21, 1968, we herewith propose for our mutual understanding and agreement as follows:

Beginning on August 28, 1968, GEOEX will furnish one complete induced polarization (I.P.) crew using standard portable or semi-portable equipment required to test for a relatively large and deep target, an area as designated by you in Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, T18S, R15E, Pima County, Arizona.

Charges will be at the rate of \$275.00 per ten hour work day including travel, prorated, for three men and equipment, plus \$50.00 per man work day extra if required and based on a five day week. Vehicle charges will be \$12.00 per day, plus 15¢ per mile per vehicle and one or two vehicles will be used. Directly related supplies, communications living and other directly incidentals charged at our cost. Final compilation, interpretation and report is \$150.00 per Tucson staff day plus directly incidental job expenses.

Mobilization and demobilization, travel, excessive weather delay and standby charges are one half the daily rate. Breakdown of our equipment in excess of one hour per day will be made up or not charged.

Personnel are to be: J. Bauersachs, Party Chief, in charge of two or more technicians or helpers. It is understood that Charles Elliot will supervise field operations.

Others of our staff are involved as needed and/or are supplied as requested and mutually agreed upon.

August 21, 1968

All property permits, brushing and trespassing-liability and related costs incurred on behalf of client assumed by client. Charges for extra equipment and personnel employed, if mutually desired, are extra.

GEOEX will save client harmless from all Workmen's Compensation, public liability and property damage liability incurred by GEOEX employees.


Preliminary reports or copies of rough field plotting sheets will be available as work progresses.

Payments due on presentation. Billings may be submitted periodically with final statement after completion of final report.

If available, we request that you furnish one reproducible, preferably a sepia or other similar type, base map for our final report plotting. Scales at or between 1"=200' to 1"=2500' would be satisfactory; otherwise, we will construct our own base map. Air photos also may be useful if available.
