

Amended notice of the claim from mine

The mining claim hereby redeclared by J. Lawrence & C. Handy, J. N. Carpenter and M. Stutz on the 6th day of May 1891 and the valid record location recorded in the county recorder office of Pima county, the present owners thereof, the undersigned, for the purpose of correcting and making more complete the description of said claim as record so as to comply with the regulations of the Land office department, first and last for record this amended notice giving a true and certain description of said claim as follows:

That the undersigned locate 1500 feet in length along this vein a ledge of mineral bearing rock by copper in width in accordance with the laws of the United States. Said claim is situated in Tombstone Mining District Cochise County Arizona, and commences at the critical monument when this notice is posted which bears N 10° 40' East distant 446 feet from U. S. mineral monument No 1, thence N 30° 45' E 677 feet to center of back end of claim thence N 61° 42' W 177 feet to stone monument thence S 36° 56' W 1441 feet to stone monument thence S 61° 42' E 252 feet to stone monument the center of front end of claim thence S 61° 42' East 300 feet to stone monument thence N 65° 04' E 1441 feet to stone monument thence N 61° 42' W 300 feet to center of W end enclosing the claim. Said mining claims retain said name of The Grandson mine.
