i. For the first two periods — ten dollars.

ii. For the last three periods — twenty dollars.

c. Submitted such substantiating data as the Commissioner may deem necessary regarding the amounts so expended.

D. Renewal; rental

1. The permittee may, prior to the expiration of each of the first four annual periods the permit is in effect, file application with the Department for renewal of the permit.

a. The application for renewal shall be on a form provided by the Commissioner and shall be accompanied by proof of annual expenditure for the current year and rental for the ensuing year in the amounts and manner as prescribed by law and these Rules and Regulations.

2. Rentals shall be payable at the time and in the amount as follows:

a. Prior to issuance of the permit, two dollars per acre for each acre designated by the Department to come under the permit.

b. Prior to the beginning of the third year and of each subsequent year, for each acre to be renewed for the third year and for each subsequent year, one dollar.

3. Upon application for renewal, properly made and supported, the Commissioner shall issue a renewal of the permit for the ensuing annual period.

E. Relinquishment of acreage by permittee

E. "Geochemical surveys" means surveys on the ground for mineral deposits by the proper application of the principles and techniques of the science of chemistry as they relate to the search for and discovery of mineral deposits.

F. "Geological surveys" means surveys on the ground for mineral deposits by the proper application of the principles and techniques of the science of geology as they relate to the search for and discovery of mineral deposits.

G. "Geophysical surveys" means surveys on the ground for mineral deposits through the employment of generally recognized equipment and methods for measuring physical differences between rocktypes or discontinuities in geological formations.

H. "Mineral" means all natural inorganic substances that may be extracted from the earth, and includes mineral compounds and aggregates, natural building stone, saline deposits, and such organic substances as coal and guano, but does not include petroleum and related hydrocarbon gases or other natural gases.

I. "Qualified expert" means an individual qualified by education or experience to conduct geological, geochemical, or geophysical surveys, as the case may be.

C. Fractions and irregular tracts. For all purposes necessary to the administration of Article 4, Chapter 2, Title 27, Arizona Revised Statutes, each fractional tract of less than twenty acres shall be considered by the Department as representing a rectangular subdivision of twenty acres.

Fractional remnants resulting from closing side lottage of township surveys shall be considered to be physically located nearest the closing side or sides of such surveys.

GENERAL COMMENTS

The above Mineral Exploration Permit is currently permitted to JABA, Inc. Via private understanding, Excellon Resources U.S., Inc. was acting as operator on an exploration project in the area. Excellon has recently optioned to discontinue its role as operator and terminate its rights as established in the afore referenced private understanding. As such, Excellon's previously performed work commitment, for the benefit of this and other parties Permits has been undertaken. JABA's understanding with Excellon was that a portion of any work undertaken would be applied toward the annual work commitment, on the above referenced Permit. Therefore, the expenditures performed, are by necessity the residual (balance carried forward) not used to offset annual expenditures for other permits, as detailed under the heading of Expenditures, below.

WORK ACCOMPLISHED

During the past lease year, JABA, Inc., as geological consultants for Excellon Resources US, Inc., has initiated a geologic evaluation of the Permit area in conjunction with other Permit areas (08-52526, 08-52728 thru 08-52730, 08-52736, 52738, & 52739) to ascertain the precious metal mineralization found there. Included in this work was a re-evaluation of previously collected factual and interpreted data, including geochemical and geophysical surveys, drilling and geological mapping. Expenditures included salaries for both office and field work performed by myself, other staff, and business associates of JABA, Inc.




