2. Application *must* be typed or printed plainly in ink and submitted to the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, having authority to issue survey orders in that State as follows: Alaska, Anchorage; Arizona, Phoenix; Arkansas and New Mexico, Sante Fe; California, Sacramento; Colorado, Denver; North and South Dakota and Montana, Billings; Nebraska, Kansas, and Wyoming, Cheyenne; Idaho, Boise; Nevada, Reno; Washington and Oregon, Portland; Utah, Salt Lake City; all other States, Director, Bureau of Land Management, Washington, D.C. 20240.
