#### 1.0 LOCATION

- ☆ The property is located approximately 24 miles east of Prescott, Arizona and very near the McCabe/Gladstone Mine of Magma Copper Co. It is situated in T13N,R1W, sections 25 & 26, and in T13N, R1E, sections 19 & 20.

#### 2.0 PROPERTY

- ☆ The Union/Condor group consists of 23 unpatented mining claims held by location. The Property is a consolidation of several old producers having a known recorded production history of 77,406 ounces of gold, 214,286 ounces of silver, and very significant credits in copper, lead, and zinc.

#### 3.0 WORK COMPLETED

- ☆ Previous development has resulted in numerous underground and surface workings, including a host of adits, several shafts and surface cuts, road construction, the remnants of three milling sites, some diamond drilling, pilot testing, and the rehabilitation of two adits.

#### 4.0 GEOLOGIC SETTING

- ☆ A multiple vein system is hosted by an intrusive granite to granodiorite. The northernmost vein system (Union) is paralleled by a lamprophyre dike and an intrusive--volcanic contact zone. At or near the contact and north of the lamprophyre dike a wide zone of brecciation and alteration is intermittently exposed along strike for nearly 4000', as are the many vein structures. The intrusive stock is bounded by what is commonly referred to as the Yavapai Schist Belt, locally consisting of andesitic to rhyolitic tuffs; the veins range in width from 6" to 10' and are traceable by surface and underground workings for more than 4000'.

#### 5.0 POTENTIAL

- ☆ The many surface and underground exposures indicate that significant potential may remain, and the limited drilling that has been completed also provides evidence that reserves below old workings remain. It is clear from the many exposures and drilling that the "hi-grade" ores will be found in pockets or shoots; yet, economically mineable ore has been left behind within the many vein structures between and adjacent to the "pockets"-----no doubt due to the "lower-grade" nature of the ore for the time period----a data package is available.




