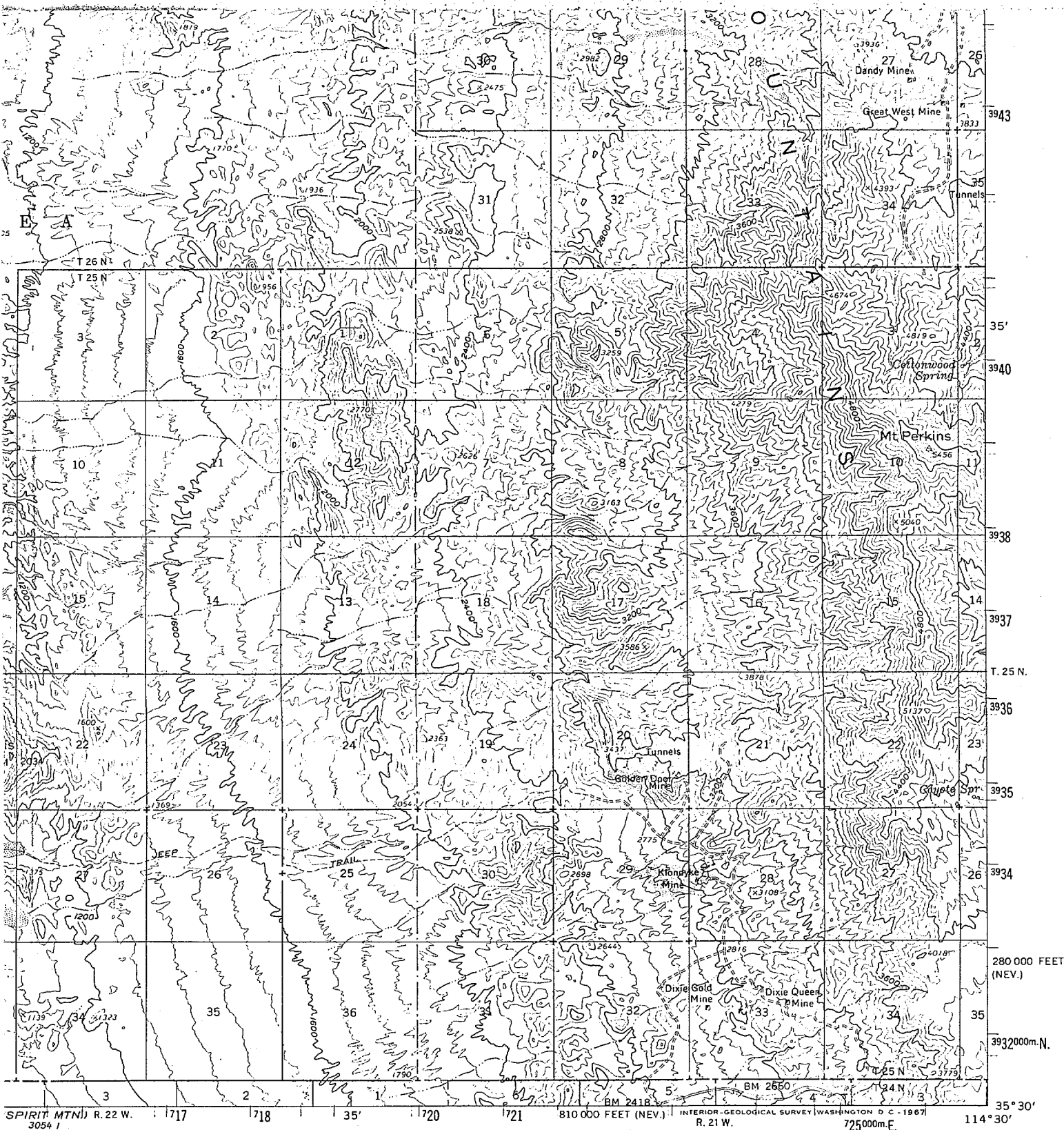

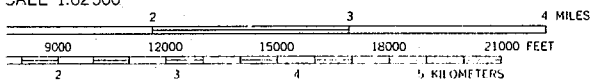

MEMORANDUM TO: W. E. Saegart

SW Klondyke Project
Superior Oil Co. Drill Hole

In talking with Ben Dickerson today he mentioned that their drill hole in the "altered" zone southwest of Klondyke is being terminated at 3350 feet after drilling several hundred (?) feet of "quartz monzonite" under 3000 + feet of volcanics. Apparently the monzonite was unaltered and unmineralized but he says, "we still have five square miles to check out so will drill another hole". This hole cost \$14.50/foot (direct) with the first 2000 feet being rotary drilled.

Mr. Ted Eyde, geologist for Superior Oil Co., stated his company had the prospect area covered by 250 claims and by one leased state section.

Mr. Eyde also discussed results of their magnetometer surveys and stated the subject area had a "sizeable magnetic high within which was a collapsed low". This low coincides with the zone of alteration.

Drilling to date consists of four rotary holes, each 2000 feet deep. The possibility of ore depths similar to the Kalamazoo deposit is a probability considered by Superior, and current plans are to deepen one of the holes to 4000 feet.

The large costs of exploration to these depths prompted a request that Superior contact ASARCO should Superior seek a partner.

According to Mr. Eyde, a pervasively altered intrusive with 3 to 5% sulfides breaches the Galiuro volcanics which are also mineralized. Grades and depths were not disclosed but Mr. Eyde said mineralization was increasing with depth in all of the holes.

A probe for the pre-mineral sediments underlying the Galiuro volcanics was unsuccessful with suspicions held by Mr. Eyde that the hole bottomed in Williamson Canyon volcanics (Silver Bell equivalent?). The thickness of the Williamson volcanics in this area is unknown so depths to the sediments is conjectural.

Unless Superior asks assistance, no further work is recommended.
