I am enclosing the materials which you loaned to me during the visit I made to your property in October - sorry it took me so long to return them!

With Carole O'Brien's approval, I am also sending my assays, a sketch map of the trench near the International shaft, and a copy of the report I wrote for Budge. I hope these will be helpful to you.

I will continue to mention your situation at Cripple Creek to people whom I believe might be interested. It is my feeling that, if the Midget-Johnson, Yellow Gold-Dager, and your property could be consolidated, it could make a very nice exploration package, both for the near-surface possibilities as well as the chance of a significant deeper discovery. Dear Carole:

This letter confirms our telephone conversation this morning, and the following agreement between A. F. Budge (Mining) Ltd. ("Budge") and Peter H. Hahn, an individual ("Hahn"):

1. Hahn agrees to make a best efforts attempt, at no further cost or obligation to Budge, to secure release of all or part of that certain Surety Bond for Reclamation Performance, dated December 12, 1985, as amended, issued in favor of the U. S. Forest Service to secure work on the Echo, Char, and LPS claims.
2. Budge agrees to release to Hahn, effective the date of execution of this letter agreement, all right, title, and interest in and to exploration data (the "data") covering mineral exploration done at Budge's cost on the Echo, Char, and LPS claims, Eureka County, Nevada, except responsibility for continuation of the Bond referred to above, and the reclamation guaranteed by said Bond. It is agreed that the data includes, but is not limited to, geological, geochemical, and geophysical data and interpretation, drill hole logs, maps, aerial photographs, and remaining samples, if any, of rocks and drill cuttings.
3. It is mutually agreed by Budge and Hahn that certain unpatented lode mining claims formerly known as the Echo, Char, and LPS claims are expired and that the same ground may have subsequently been relocated by third parties, and that Hahn may enter into business arrangements with these or other parties concerning the data, and convey the data to any party of his choosing, without recourse by Budge, subject to the provision that if Hahn sells the data outright for cash, Budge shall receive ten percent (10%) of the proceeds of this transaction.



We would like to apologize for the delay in responding to your request to release the bond held for the Echo-Char claims in the Monitor Range. Due to heavy work loads and lack of personnel, we were unable to examine the progress of revegetation on your project. Your claims were last inspected in October of 1987. At that time there was no vegetative growth evident. As we will need to measure the growth to release the bond, inspection will take place in June or July of 1989 when seed heads will make plant identification possible.
