Dear Ed,

I am writing you on behalf of Reynolds Metals Exploration, Inc. regarding access across patented mining claims near the Moss mine in Mohave county, Arizona. Reynolds is seeking permission to use the existing 4x4 roads for drill rig access to our RAL claims and Compass Minerals' AL and ALX claims.

Reynolds is currently in the permitting and bidding process, and hopes to drill by late October this year. A track-mounted reverse circulation drill program is planned. Equipment would include the drill rig, a water truck, driller's support 4x4 pick-up, and geologist's pick-up.

The enclosed map is a reduced portion of the Oatman 7½ minute topo map showing in red the proposed access route. The outline of patented claims is shaded blue for reference. The boundaries as shown are plotted from county BLM records, and therefore are only approximate.
