
The Eldorado Mine, shown as the Malco Mine on the Garnet Mtn Quadrangle map was visited. There was no one at the property but the equipment appeared to have been operated recently. There was a tracked frontend loader, a rubber tired front end loader, a water truck and camp trailer on site.

The equipment consisted of a jaw crusher, a screen, a gyratory crusher, a set of rolls and a vibrating inclined plate agglomerator. The pad was partially loaded with the pelletized ore. Above ground swimming pools are being used for solutions and there is a small building to house the extraction and laboratory equipment.


It appeared that either crushed ore or leach residue had been used to surface the road from the Eldorado to the O.K. Excelsior.

Due to a locked gate and time constraints none of the mine workings were visited.




QUADRANGLE LOCATION



## PRECIOUS METAL RESOURCES

Much of the work done during the past several years has been directed towards identifying precious metal deposits. Where this activity has been successful, it is likely additional work and perhaps production will occur. Information on these sites is of interest for planning and investment purposes to industry and government groups. Thus the following table of precious metal resource estimates is included in this report.

Estimates of precious metal resources are included for many of the properties previously discussed in this report and for some mines currently in production. The data provided has been gathered from many sources which include company annual reports, mining industry periodicals, unpublished geologic reports and personal communication. Some of the figures listed have been reported as reserves while two are based on a geologic estimate. Most of those reported fall somewhere in between where drilling or sampling has indicated a potential size and grade in place, but insufficient work has been done to confirm a reserve. Data on dumps and tailings is also included. Where known, additional comments about the sites such as operational status, whether available by underground or open pit, if metallurgical problems exist and associated base metals or silica, have been noted.

Additional resources are known to exist at other properties but insufficient data was available to quantify them for this report. Further information on these properties and known resources of other commodities in Arizona is available at the Department's offices.





The Eldorado mine was examined on Jan. 6, 1989. The mine is located in the Gold Basin district in Mohave County, approximately 60 miles north of Kingman, Arizona. It lies at an altitude of about 4000 feet in the White Hills (Fig. 1). The mine is reached by a good dirt road extending four miles off of the Pierce Ferry road.

It is difficult to reconstruct the history of mining in the Gold Basin District. The district is reported to have produced \$50,000 to \$100,000 (2400 - 4800 ounces) worth of gold from the 1870's to 1900, most of which came from the Eldorado mine. Production since then is unknown.

The underground workings are stated to consist of 2000 feet of adit tunnels and 40,000 cubic feet of stopes on three levels, extending to 200 feet below the uppermost vein outcrop. I estimate 40,000 cubic feet of stopes would produce 3200 tons of rock.

In recent years, some production has apparently come from cyanide leaching of dump material. Two four foot channel samples (ED - 1 and ED - 2, Table 1) were cut on the east and south faces of a small (about 1700 tons) wedge of crushed rock. Both assays show significant grades of gold and trace silver, averaging 0.21 opt. Au. Though those assays suggest that cyanide leaching of the dump would be marginally profitable at best, more samples are needed in order to make a final conclusion.

The vein seen at the portal of the underground workings, though not directly examined, appears to consist of about one foot of iron-stained quartz striking N50E and dipping 65 SE. The vein is nearly completely stoped, with small remnant pillars visible in the back. A grab sample from wallrock schist in the portal assays 0.065 opt Au (sample ED - 3). This shows that there is some dissemination of gold into the wallrocks, creating potential for a much larger tonnage of ore and potential for open - cut mining.


The top of the hill has been stripped in two benches (Fig. 2). A large group of holes were also drilled. Stopes from the tunnels below apparently do not extend to the crest of the hill, but the vein appears to be exposed, assaying 0.110 opt Au (sample ED -5). Two channel samples in the hangingwall up to 30' away from the principal vein assayed 0.002 and 0.065 opt Au (ED - 4 and ED - 6).

The higher assay is encouraging because it again suggests that there is potential for gold ore in the wallrocks.

In order to determine the feasibility of working the Eldorado property, it is recommended that ten days be spent mapping and sampling the surface and underground mine workings. Furthermore, additional samples should be taken of the dump material. Projected costs for the mapping project are tabulated in Table 2. Table 3 shows the costs of basic field equipment which will be necessary for underground mine examination. By shopping around, we can get some of this equipment much more cheaply than the costs shown here.



